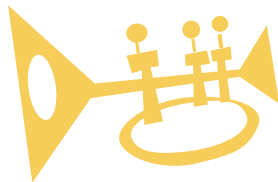
Why LMS?

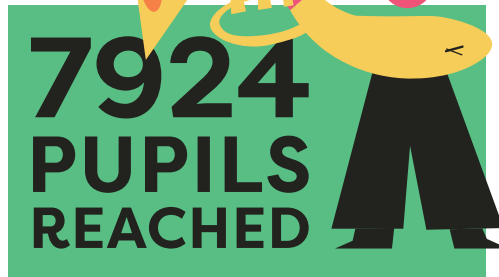

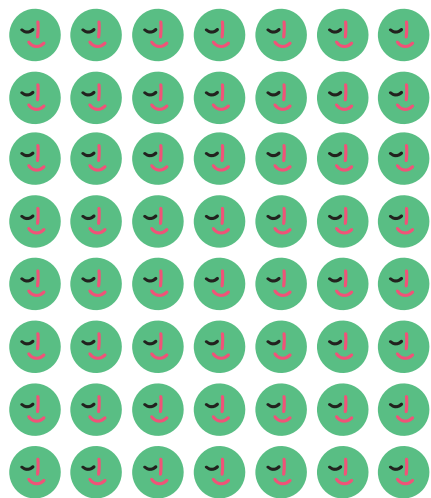

MASH UP INITIAL ACCESS

A beginner module delivered over one term where instrumental, performance and social skills are taught using a variety of different instruments and technology, rhythm games and singing.

- 1 term (around 12 weeks) of weekly 45 min initial whole-class instrumental or technology-based tuition.

TOGETHER THROUGH MUSIC

SEND Provision

A project of around 12 weeks school-based music sessions, training, and network building that will result in a unique, sustainable music education for all young people with additional needs in Lincolnshire. Options include:

- Sensory Music – A flexible creative music-making programme which can be adapted to suit the needs of the students. Aimed at PMLD students to develop cognitive, communication and social skills.
- Accelerate – A powerful combination of singing and drumming designed as a language intervention programme but also effective at developing coordination, motivation, listening skills, social skills and concentration. Aimed at children with identified Literacy or Speech

and language difficulties.

- Music Tech – Digital music-making through the use of iPads. Focusing on composition and performance, the use of technology provides an accessible platform for students to develop confidence, concentration and collaborative group working.
- Percussion and Ukulele – Whole class or small group music-making using percussion instruments including djembe, samba and taiko. Performance and social skills are taught using a variety of different instruments, rhythm games and songs.

A progression pathway from Mash Up Initial Access.

- 1 term (around 12 weeks) of elective 1 x 30 min weekly large-group instrumental or technology-based learning.
- Inclusive of Instruments and/or access to technology.

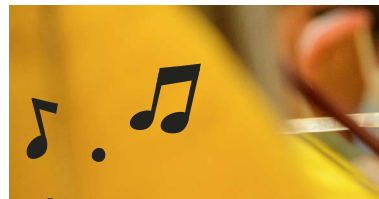

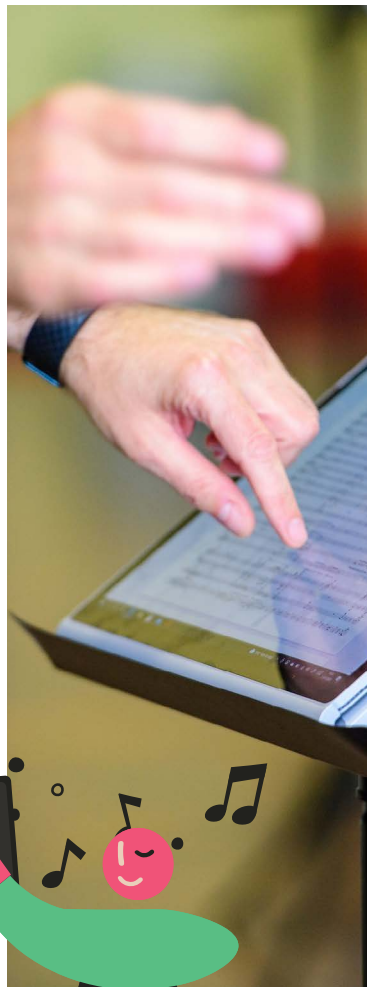
In school Music Tech exploration will be looking at:

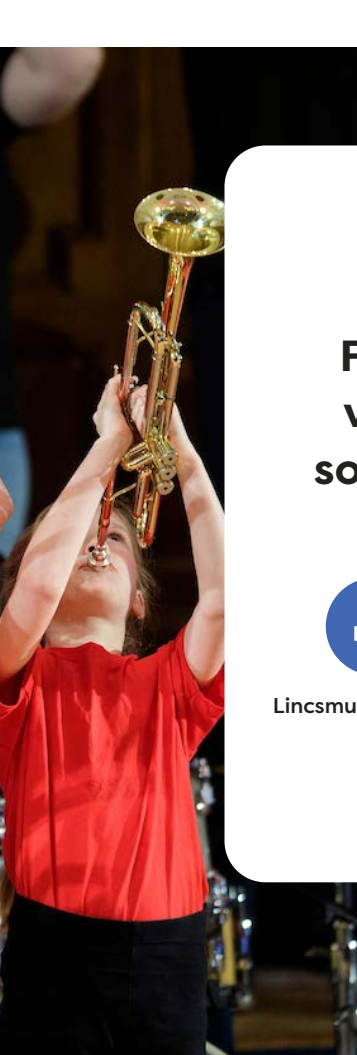
